Let's do a very quick review of inequality basics that you probably first learned about in second grade. Radical Function Graphs. First of all, let's see what some basic radical function graphs look like. The first set of graphs are the quadratics and the square root functions; since the square root function "undoes" the quadratic function, it makes sense that it looks like a quadratic on its side. Graphs of Absolute Value Functions. Note that you can put absolute values in your Graphing Calculator (and even graph them!) by hitting MATH, scroll right to NUM, and then hitting 1 (abs) or ENTER.
