Critical incident stress management (CISM) is an adaptive, short-term psychological helping-process that focuses solely on an immediate and identifiable problem. The Critical Incident Technique (or CIT) is a set of procedures used for collecting direct observations of human behavior that have critical significance and meet methodically defined criteria. However, unwanted events still occur. These include incidents such as underground fires, coal dust explosions, fall of ground and over-exposure to harmful substances.
