An Archaeology of Capitalism offers an account of landscape and material culture from the later Middle Ages to the beginnings of the Industrial Revolution. In *An Archaeology of Social Space*, James A. Historical materialism is the methodological approach of Marxist historiography that focuses on human societies and their development over time, arguing that they follow a number of observable tendencies.
