A March 25, 1914 letter to Felice exemplifies these qualities, including Kafka's tendency to "berate" his fiancé and to "backpedal" from the serious possibility of marriage. Franz Kafka (3 July 1883 – 3 June 1924) was a German-speaking Bohemian Jewish novelist and short story writer, widely regarded as one of the major figures of 20th-century literature.
