INTRODUCTION. Esophageal cancer presents as localized disease, defined as adenocarcinoma or squamous cell carcinoma confined to the esophagus, in approximately 22 percent of all cases. Regional disease, which includes spread to regional lymph nodes, accounts for another 30 percent of patients with esophageal cancer.
